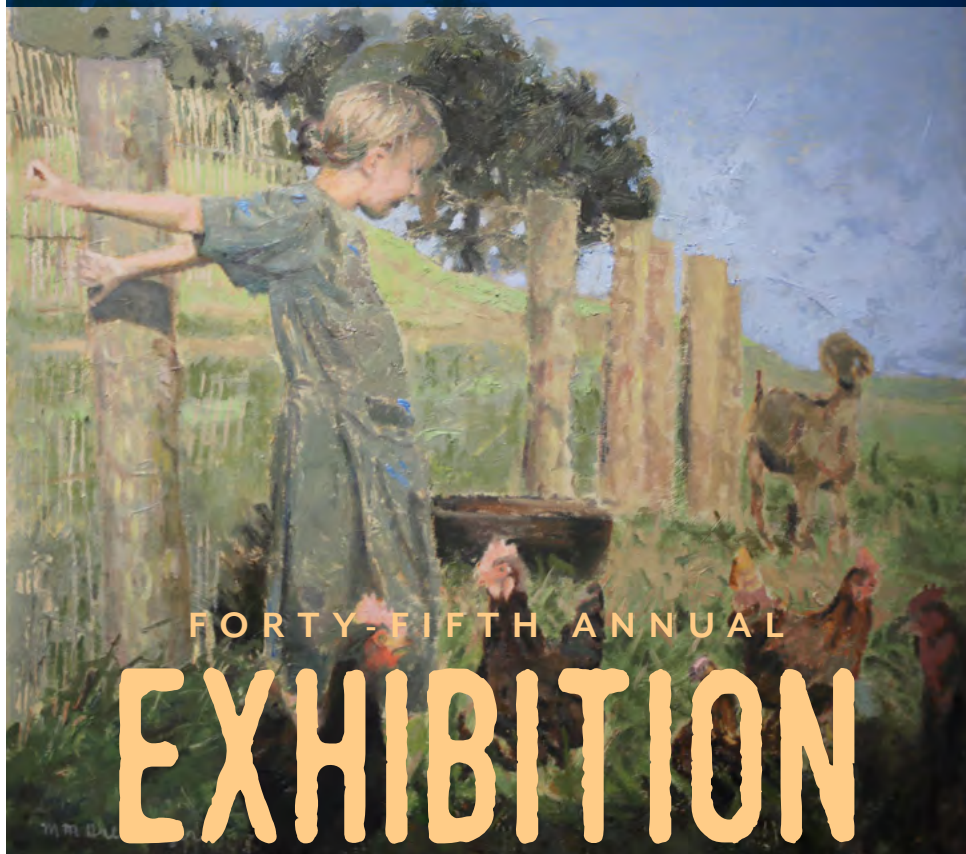

OUR HISTORY

Indiana Heritage Arts, a nonprofit art organization, was founded in 1979 with the purpose of nurturing the rich art heritage of Brown County, “The Art Colony of the Midwest.” All IHA activities are centered on broadening the appreciation and knowledge of art, advancing art interests and ensuring that Indiana’s historic art heritage continues.

An elected board of directors, with the help and support of IHA members and other volunteers, produces IHA’s programs. Programs are funded by statewide memberships and are supplemented by generous donations of money, goods and services by patrons, merchants and corporations statewide. Programs include workshops, demonstrations, maintaining a gallery exhibition space within the Brown County Art Gallery, and the organization and promotion of an annual exhibition and sale.

Additionally, over the past 16 years Indiana Heritage Arts has assembled a permanent collection of paintings by present day Indiana artists. These works are currently exhibited at the offices of the Brown County Community Foundation, West Baden Springs Hotel in West Baden, Indiana, and at the Brown County Art Gallery.

IHA, with the help of financial supporters and volunteers, organizes a juried exhibition and sale of fine art by Indiana artists each June. Works are juried by a professional artist/judge, and currently twenty-three awards totaling more than \$20,000 are presented. IHA’s board of directors selects a painting from this exhibition for purchase for its permanent collection, thus honoring an artist and ensuring that Brown County’s rich art heritage continues.

IHA is pleased to announce that Utah artist **SHANNA KUNZ** will serve as judge for the 2023 Exhibition and Sale.

Shanna Kunz is a contemporary landscape painter, raised with a strong connection to the land and a deep sense of place. Her upbringing in the Wasatch Mountains of Northern Utah, as well as her experiences exploring the mountain ranges and deserts of the West, have heavily influenced her work. Art, music, and family have been constant sources of inspiration for Shanna and have helped shape her unique voice as a painter.

In her work, Shanna seeks to capture intimate imagery that resonates emotionally with her viewers, rather than depicting specific locations. Her paintings are characterized by their complexity, moodiness, and honesty, and are often described as transcendental by those who view them.

JUDGE'S STATEMENT

It was my pleasure to Jury and Judge this amazing show! The quality of art compares to any museum juried show and it was very difficult to pick out 100 pieces out of the submitted entries.

Art history has always been a passion of mine and it was thrilling to find pieces that had the spirit of your Indiana Brown County past masters. I was afforded the opportunity to see some original work from them and study the book on their works. And speaking of masters, you have many in this show that reflect those masters qualities!

When I am jurying a show, my first round through is to pick what absolutely speaks to me. I am looking for a very authentic voice in the work first and foremost. All of my many next rounds through the show are pieces that are studied thoroughly for composition, making sure the eye moves through the painting with a beautiful rhythm. I look for color palettes, subtleties and sophistications. Some pieces I chose because of the amazing contrast of Greys vs. Saturated colors. I love good handling of values that reflect an organized design. I am always looking for an emotional connection to the piece, usually shown by atmosphere and shape placement. I love a painting that has a dominance of thick/thin paint texture and a lyrical brushwork, but I love a thin passage as well.

MARY GRETSINGER

After School

MARY GRETSINGER believes that through closely examining work of great masters of the past, one can find a unique voice in the art world of the present. She painted and sketched since she was three years old, and was known as the “class artist” since early grade school. The catalyst to her becoming a serious artist was studying extensively with internationally acclaimed watercolorist Cheng Khee Chee while pursuing her bachelor’s degree at the University of Minnesota, Duluth. He taught her the basic science behind light and design, and also encouraged her to study the great masters of the past and present. Since then, she has won numerous awards including those at local, statewide, and national levels. She is a signature member of the Watercolor Society of Indiana, and the nationally acclaimed Kentucky Watercolor Society. Since 2008, she has worked primarily with oil painting, although she saves a special place in her heart for watercolor.

CHARLES WARREN MUNDY, was born and raised in Indianapolis, Indiana. He graduated with a Fine Art Degree and a Secondary Education Teaching Degree from Ball State University in 1969 and then worked on a Masters of Fine Art at Long Beach State (CA).

From an early age, Mundy demonstrated a propensity for drawing and athletics. In 1978, he combined his love for art and sports and worked as a sports illustrator for over a decade.

In the early 1990s, Mundy sought a different approach to painting and took on the challenge of painting in a more impressionistic style, going out of doors and painting “en plein air” and “from life”. Mundy moved away from the restrictions of illustrative art to a looser brush style and freer expression in Impressionism.
